

# A Day in Smyrna, TN.



Start your day with a morning hike at **Percy Priest Lake**, part of Long Hunter State Park, or go for a jog along the **Smyrna Greenway**, then grab a hearty breakfast at **First Watch**.



Head to the **Smyrna Depot** to see an 1873 landmark that was once part of the Nashville & Chattanooga railroad, connecting our area with Charleston and New Orleans! Then visit the **Historic Sam Davis Home & Plantation** – the boyhood plantation home of a Confederate hero who was hanged at the age of 21. If you go between harvests, you'll see the fields of cotton that the Davis family grew.

For lunch, grab some burgers and famous fried dill pickles at **Toot's Restaurant**, one of the locals' favorites, or head to **Karin's Kustard** for an old-fashioned burger and shake experience.



Take a fun, motorized—and FREE—tour through the multi-billion dollar **Nissan North America plant**, which produces several of the top Nissan vehicles, including the all-electric LEAF®. See all parts of the vehicle assembly process, from cutting large sheets of steel to painting the exterior and installing carpet. Check out the robots zooming around the plant to deliver parts! Tours are offered Tuesdays and Thursdays at 10:00 am and 1:00 pm and you'll have to get advance reservations, but it's worth it!

If you come in the summer, beat the heat at the **Splash Pad**, a water playground with fountains, spouts and more. In the fall, visit **Walden Pumpkin Farm** to pick your own pumpkins and gourds, take home some Indian corn and straw bales, and even sample pumpkin fudge!

For dinner, taste the best of Polynesian and Hawaiian cuisine at the popular **Omni Hut**, or treat your taste buds to **Hickory Falls Wood-Fired Grille & Bar** and enjoy steaks, pasta and more.

After dinner, take in a performance at **Springhouse Theatre!**
